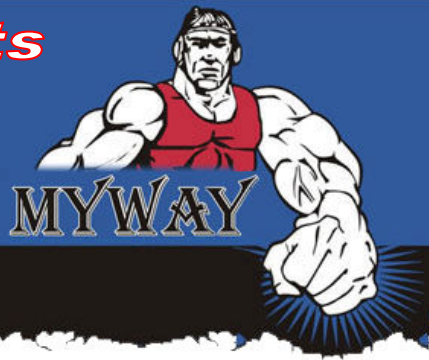

AGE GROUPS Age Groups are determined by year of birth.

Proof of age will be required if wrestler is challenged within the first two rounds of competition. A birth certificate is the only form of validation that will be accepted.

RULES Modified High School Rules

- Must be in grade 8th or under. Anyone born in 94 must send proof they're in 8th when registering for MYWA.
- All Michigan residents 8th grade and under **MUST** be a MYWA member to compete in post season events.
- Age Groups 05-03, 02-01: three, 1 minute periods
- Age Groups 00-99, 98-97, 96-94: three, 1 1/2 minute periods
- Singlets or t-shirt and shorts are required.
- One step on scale at weigh-ins
- Mouth guards **Mandatory** for wrestlers with braces
- Hair caps attached to headgear **Mandatory** for wrestlers not groomed to HS standards.
(Hair length must be above eyebrow, earlobes, and collar.)
- If less than three wrestlers are in a weight class, the tournament has the right to move them up one weight class (in the same age group) except for heavyweight.
